Fr. Warren J. Savage is a priest of the Diocese of Springfield, Massachusetts. He is an international and national speaker, lecturer, and mission preacher. Fr. Savage has served as a parish priest, dean, educator, spiritual director, and administrator throughout Western Massachusetts, and is currently on the faculty for the Diocesan Permanent Diaconate Formation Program and the Religious Studies Department of the College of Our Lady of the Elms, Chicopee, MA. Fr. Savage serves as the Catholic Chaplain at Westfield State University, Westfield, MA and Amherst College, Amherst, MA.

A member of the Academy of Homiletics, Fr. Savage is also a member of The Society for the Study of Christian Spirituality and a member and the past Vice President of the National Black Catholic Clergy Caucus. He has been involved in prison ministry and in ministry with people living with HIV/AIDS. He has done extensive work in the areas of lay ministry formation, youth ministry, social justice, anti-racism, multicultural and diversity training, and cross-cultural ministry in Africa and Central America. Savage's missions attract hundreds of people of all ages and from all walks of life.
